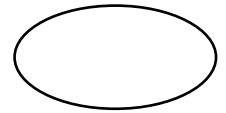


WOODTURNING



ENTRY CATEGORIES

N = Novice = Less than two (2) years turning experience.

O = Open = Over two (2) years turning experience

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries must be certified as the sole work of the entrant.

Entries must have been completed within the last 12 months.

Stewards have the right to remove an item, which doesn't meet the requirements of the class description

Stewards have the right to remove an item from one class and place it into another class

The judges decision is final.

All entries attract an entry fee of \$2.

A maximum of (2) two entries per class per entrant is allowed.

An entry form must be completed listing Category Class and Description of each entry and fee attached

All entries must be with Stewards by no later then 11 am on Friday 24th June 2011. Any entry received after 11 am will only be accepted at the discretion of the stewards.

There must be only one article entered as a entry except in Class 9 Paired Items and only identical Pairs will be accepted.

AWARDS

Less than five entries in a class **1st and Judges commendation award.**

Greater than 5 entries in a class **1st, 2nd, and judges commendation award.**

Champion Exhibit of the show. Reserve Champion exhibit of the show. Judges encouragement award.

The Champion exhibit Open and Champion exhibit Novice, Reserve Champion exhibit Open and Reserve Champion exhibit Novice will be decided from winners of all of the preliminary classes in the Open and the Novice Categories

FEEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY. You can pay when you bring your entries to the clubhouse on the Wednesday Night before the Show or at the showgrounds on the day of judging.

Review of Mudgeeraba show Classes and recommendations for the future

Out of the thirty Classes available at the Mudgeeraba show only one class was not entered in the open class that being 15 Bandsaw. However in the Novice class there were 5 classes, Vases/ Urns, Offset Turning, Goblets, Miniature, and Segmental Turning, all of these classes are not really suited to a novice turner.

We are recommending that we reduce the classes to twenty five, by eliminating the five classes above from the Novice section

Other recommendations are replace Bandsaw with Pyrography, combining Goblets with Vases/ Urns and introducing a new class of Paired items.

A new restriction is required as to how many items can be entered as a exhibit and our recommendation is only one item per entry, with a maximum of two entries for each class. We have a new class for pairs and that is where you can enter multiple identical items.

We are recommending a new award for **Most successful Exhibiter of the show**, be introduced. This award is to encourage members to put in multiple entries and there by making our displays more spatular. The awarding of the points for this award will be as follows:

Three (3) plus entries in a class

1st — 5 Points
2nd —3 Points
3rd — 1 Point

Two (2) Entries in a Class

1st — 3 Points
2nd—1 Point

One (1) entry in a class

1st — 2 points
